This form must be completed and submitted to support an application for a child (i.e. a person under 18 years who has never married) where a required consent has not been obtained from each person who has parental responsibility for the child and there is no Australian court order which permits the issue of a travel document. For the purpose of obtaining a travel document, parental responsibility is defined in subsection 11(5) of the *Australian Passports Act 2005* available at www.passports.gov.au

It is your responsibility to obtain the consent of each person whose consent is required. This form should be completed only when you have exhausted all efforts to obtain the required consents. A separate form is required for each person with parental responsibility who has not provided their written consent.

- **Child applications without full consent take longer to process (generally six to eight weeks) so normal turnaround times do not apply. A priority processing fee will not accepted before this application is approved.**
- **There is no guarantee that a child application without full consent will be approved. You should not make firm travel bookings until you know whether a travel document will be issued to your child.**
- **The special circumstances that are considered in assessing an application without full consent are set out in subsection 11(2) of the *Australian Passport Act 2005* (the Act) and section 10 of the Australian Passports Determination 2015 (the Determinations).
